

LESSON 2 – IDENTITY & DEVELOPMENT – BECOMING WHO WE ARE CALLED TO BE

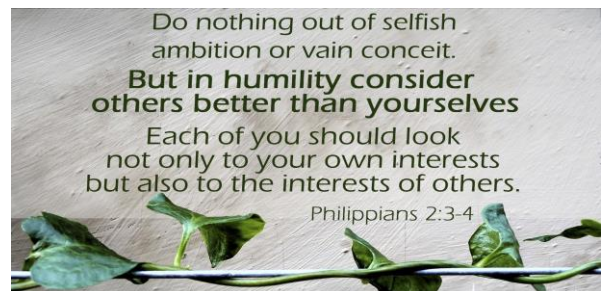
Important points:

- Our Uniqueness & our shared characteristics are part of God's plan for Humanity.
- It's each one of us who bring together our uniqueness to build a community that we live in.
- People are not comparable, no one is better than anyone else. Everyone is unique and has their own struggles and achievements.
- Be humble and accept each one as your own.
- Enjoyment and entertainment can always be found where friends are, but, we need to try hard to keep reminding each other that Christ should be the center of our friendship.

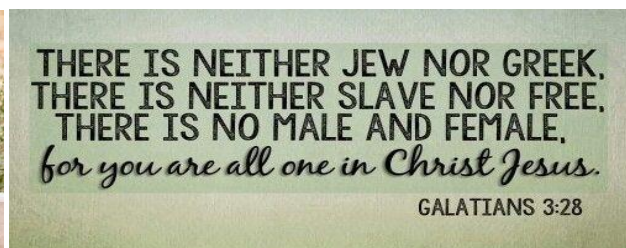
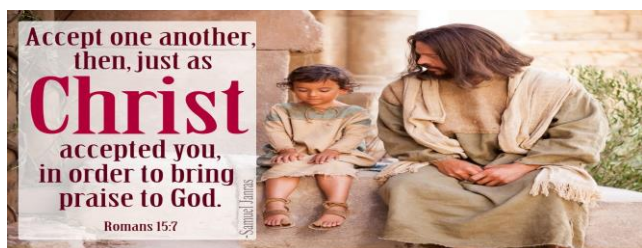
