- **descendants** – A person's children, their children's children, and all the people who live after them who are related to them
- **Covenant** – God's Promise to Man (friendship pact)
- **herdsmen** – people who watch over the cows, sheep and other animals

Although God did not tell Abram the place he had to go to, Abram believed and did what God told him to do.
