Words to Know

Penance is: Something we do to show we are sorry for doing wrong.

Absolve means " Take away".

Contrition is being Sorry for doing wrong.

Act of Contrition is a prayer of Sorrow.

Amen means "Yes I believe or Yes "let it be "

Questions to Answer.

1. How can we show that we are sorry for doing wrong?

By saying that we are sorry in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

2. After we tell our sins to the priest what will the priest do?

Help us choose an act of Penance.

3. What prayer do we say right before absolution in the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

We say the Act of Contrition.

4. What does the priest do to show that God forgives our sins?

The priest puts his hand over our head and he says "I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit".
