Lesson 7: Religious Faith - More Than the Eye Can See

Objective:

- To alert the candidates that reflection on matters of faith requires a particular mind-set and outlook.
- To increase the candidates awareness and conviction that exploring matters of faith can be engaging, exciting and enjoyable.
- To move the candidate towards more serious reflection upon their experience and understanding of God.

What is Faith?

<u>FAITH</u> is the understanding that each person has of God and how that person views life in terms of that understanding. In simple terms to have faith means to have a personal relationship with God. Faith is Private and mysterious. To some extent Faith is unique to each person – not because God is different but because people are different.

What is Religion?


<u>RELIGION</u> is a way for people to express outwardly their inner experiences of God. It is an attempt by people to share and make public that faith relationship with God, using outward signs, gestures, rituals, and statements of belief. Each culture develops its own religion expression and this is passed from generation to generation.

WHAT IS RELIGION?



- · A Set of beliefs in an ultimate reality
- A Set of practices used to express those beliefs
- It is a key component of culture
- Has its own special celebrations and worship styles
- Have their own sacred text, symbols and sites
- All of these aspect help unite followers regardless of where in the world they live

What do you understand between Faith & Religion



Even though the term Faith and Religion are different they are closely related.

Faith – the personal relationship with God – requires the means of expression that religion provides. **Religion** – the outward expression of the inner faith.

Faith and religion need each other. If Faith is lost religion becomes meaningless.

What does the Bible explain Faith as:

Faith is confident in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. (Hebrew Ch 11:1)

Faith can move mountains. (Matt 17:20)


