THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN (Luke 10: 25-37)

Just then a lawyer stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he said, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?". He said to him, "What is written in the law? What do you read there?"

He answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself."

And he said to him, "You have given the right answer; do this, and you will live."


But wanting to justify himself, he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell into the hands of robbers, who stripped him, beat him, and went away, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a priest was going down that road; and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. So likewise a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan while traveling came near him; and when he saw him, he was moved with pity. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, having poured oil and wine on them. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take

care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever more you spend.'

Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the

robbers?"



He said, "The one who showed him mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

LOVING GOD and OUR NEIGHBOR

The greatest commandment is to Love God with all our heart and soul and strength, and to love our neighbor as ourselves.

The most important thing you do in your life is loving God. If you really love God then you will do what is right and love other people as well. The Samaritan in the story loved God even though he didn't worship Him in the proper way like the Jews did. But because He loved God he wanted to please Him by being kind to his enemy.

If you don't love God then you will not be able to make good decisions about other things either. You can't even love other people properly if you don't love God the most. The priest and Levite in the parable probably cared more about themselves than about God. That is why when they saw their own countryman injured and lying by the roadside they just walked past.

Is God the most important thing in your life? Talk to Him every day and you will grow to love Him. You can be a good neighbor to everyone by being a good friend of God.

- Eternal life: Life after death
- **Neighbor:** A person who lives near you.
- Inn: A place to stay for a day or two in exchange for money
- Mercy: showing compassion, kindness.
- Priest: a person who serves in the temple and offers prayers and sacrifices to God on behalf of the people.
- Levite: a person who assists the priest and takes care of the temple.
- Samaritan: A man who lives in Samaria, very much hated by the Jews

- Pity: Feeling sad at other's suffering.
- **Inherit**: To be given / to be rewarded
- **Stripped**: To be robbed; clothes or covering to be taken off
