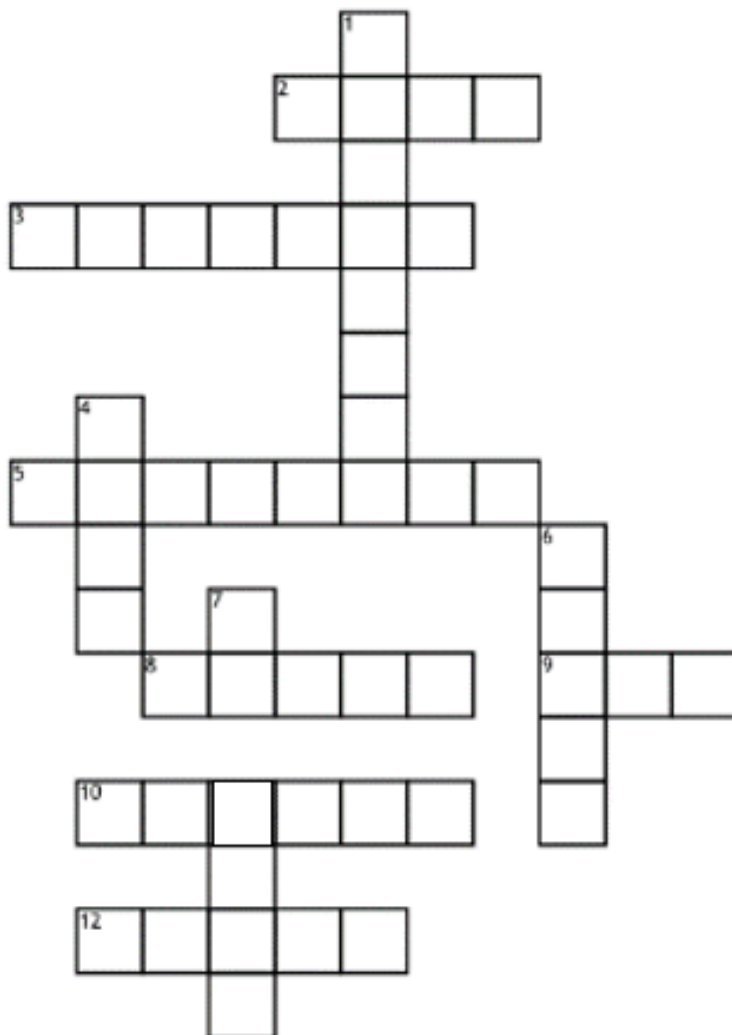
## Chapter 9:
