

INVITATION 9 – THE CHURCH – CALLED TO LIVE IN COMMUNITY

Important points:

- ✚ The Church is not a building, but all the people who believe in Jesus Christ as their saviour.
- ✚ The first Christians gathered together regularly to hear people teach about Jesus.
- ✚ The first Christians spent time together as friends. They shared meals and prayed together. They helped each other and were generous. They worshiped God together.
- ✚ Even though the things in the Bible happened a long time ago, the same things happen at church today.
- ✚ We need to start seeing the church not as a service to meet our needs, but a family for whom we bear responsibility.
- ✚ To know that we all have a role to play in the building of “The Church”
- ✚ The best way by which a child can contribute to the building of “The Church” is “by Praying for himself as well as others”.
- ✚ The Holy Spirit plays a very important role & will prepare them for the next session of Formation, where they will desire out of their own free will to learn more about the Holy Spirit & be prepared to be confirmed in faith.

1. What is the Church?

The Church is the gathering of people who profess faith in the risen Jesus and his message and who through the power of the Holy Spirit, live a life of loving service to everyone. The church is primarily **people**, a community of believers bound together by a common **faith** in Jesus. ***The real church is you and me.***

2. How does community help us to grow in faith?

Community attracts the Holy Spirit.

Community fosters love. It teaches us to love in unity & harmony.

Community is forgiving. If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly father will forgive you.

Community shows us how important it is to respect each one and be selfless in our way of living.

Community encourages us. It helps us to stand up when we fall.

Pope, Cardinals, Archbishops, Bishops, Priests, Deacons & the Laity (People)

He took a yoke of oxen, and cut them in pieces and sent them throughout all the territory of Israel by messengers, saying, "Whoever does not come out after Saul and Samuel, so shall it be done to his oxen!"
- (6) How were the Ammonites defeated?
Saul put the people in three companies. At the morning watch they came into the camp and cut down the Ammonites until the heat of the day; and those who survived were scattered so that no two of them were left together.
- (7) Who did the people want Samuel to bring to them after the battle so that they could be put to death?
Those that had said "Shall Saul reign over us".
- (8) What was Saul's answer to their request?
No one shall be put to death this day for today the Lord has brought deliverance to Israel.
- (9) Where did Samuel take the people to renew the Kingship of Saul?
Gilgal and there they made Saul king before the Lord.

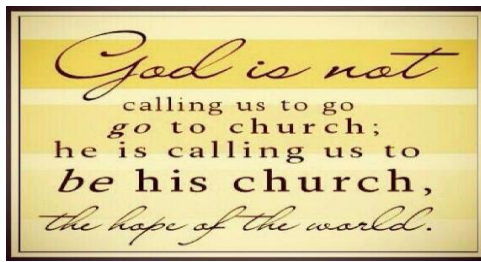
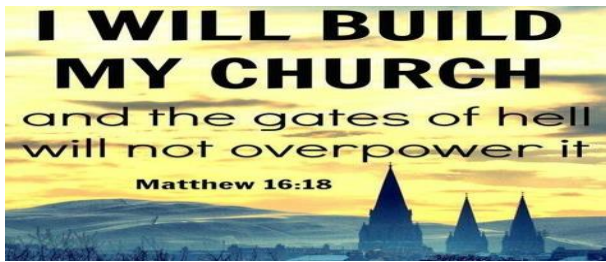
The Precepts of the Church

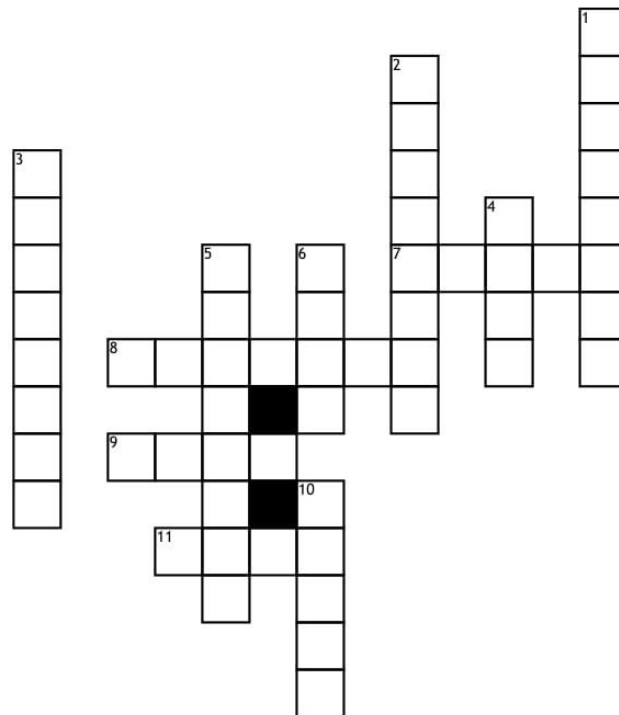
TEACHING TO PRAY: THIS IS HOW YOU CAN STRENGTHEN YOUR PRAYER LIFE
