Words to Know:

Last Supper: The Holy Supper Jesus had with his Apostles the night before he died. At the last supper Jesus gave us his Body and Blood.

Priest: A man who has received the power from Jesus to forgive sins and offer mass.

Holy Communion: The receiving of the Body and Blood of Jesus.

Gospel: The Good News of Jesus mentioned in the first four books of the New Testament. They are the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.



Questions and Answers:

Q1: What is the Mass?

A1. The Mass is the sacrifice of the Body and the Blood of Jesus Christ, which is offered on the altar by the priest to God, under the appearances of bread and wine, in memory of the sacrifice of the Cross and in renewal of the sacrifice of the Cross.

Q2. Why has Christ given Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist?

A2. Christ has given Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist to be the life and food our souls.
