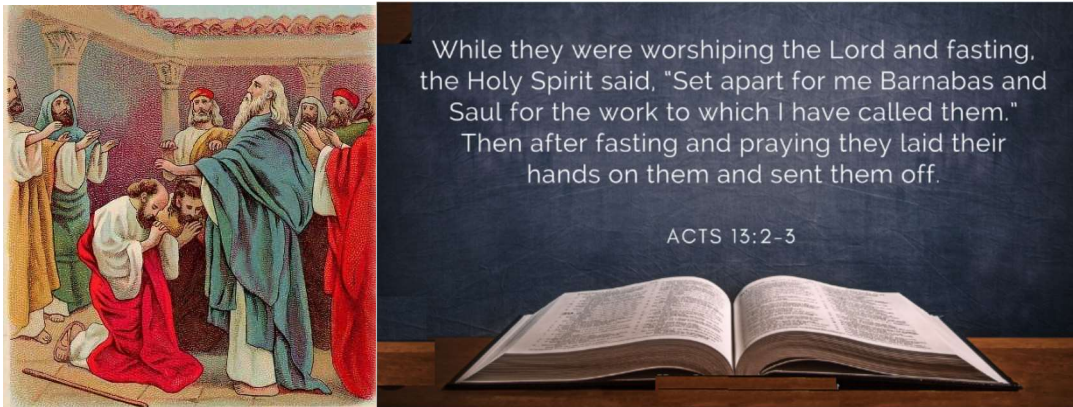


# ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

### Barnabas and Saul Commissioned....

- i. <sup>03</sup> Then after **fasting** and **praying** the prophets and church teachers at Antioch laid their **hands** on Barnabas and Saul, and sent them off on their first missionary journey.
- ii. <sup>04</sup> Barnabas and Saul first sailed to **Cyprus**.
- iii. <sup>05</sup> They preached in the Jewish synagogues at Salamis, with **John** as their assistant.
- iv. <sup>07</sup> **Sergius Paulus** at Paphos desired to hear the word of God.
- v. <sup>09</sup> From Chapter 13 onwards, Luke refers to Saul as **Paul**.
- vi. <sup>11</sup> Elymas became **blind** when he tried to turn away the proconsul from the faith.
- vii. <sup>26</sup> "Brothers and sisters, you descendants of Abraham's family and others who fear God, to us the message of this **Salvation** has been sent".
- viii. As great as David was, his purpose was for his own generation. He did God's will, and then died, and his body decayed, <sup>37</sup> but Jesus whom God raised up experienced no **corruption**.
- ix. <sup>39</sup> Through **Jesus** everyone who believes is set free from all those sins, from which the Law of Moses could not free you.
- x. <sup>45</sup> When the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy; and contradicting and blaspheming, they opposed the things spoken by **Paul**.
- xi. <sup>46</sup> Since the Jews rejected the word of God and judged themselves unworthy of eternal life, Paul said he would turn his teachings towards the **Gentiles**.
- xii. <sup>51</sup> Paul and Barnabas shook the **dust** from their feet, when they were expelled from Antioch in Pisidia, and went to **Iconium**.
- xiii. <sup>52</sup> The disciples were filled with **Joy** and with the **Holy Spirit**.
