

FILL IN THE BLANKS: (Answers)

- i. ⁰³ Then after <u>fasting</u> and <u>praying</u> the prophets and church teachers at Antioch laid their <u>hands</u> on Barnabas and Saul, and sent them off on their first missionary journey.
- ii. ⁰⁴ Barnabas and Saul first sailed to **Cyprus.**
- iii. ⁰⁵ They preached in the Jewish synagogues at Salamis, with **John** as their assistant.
- iv. ⁰⁷ Sergius Paulus at Paphos desired to hear the word of God.
- v. ⁰⁹ From Chapter 13 onwards, Luke refers to Saul as **Paul**.
- vi. ¹¹ Elymas became **blind** when he tried to turn away the proconsul from the faith.
- vii. ²⁶ "Brothers and sisters, you descendants of Abraham's family and others who fear God, to us the message of this **Salvation** has been sent".
- viii. As great as David was, his purpose was for his own generation. He did God's will, and then died, and his body decayed, ³⁷ but Jesus whom God raised up experienced no **corruption**.
- ix. ³⁹Through <u>Jesus</u> everyone who believes is set free from all those sins, from which the Law of Moses could not free you.
- x. ⁴⁵ When the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy; and contradicting and blaspheming, they opposed the things spoken by **Paul**.
- xi. ⁴⁶ Since the Jews rejected the word of God and judged themselves unworthy of eternal life, Paul said he would turn his teachings towards the **Gentiles**.
- xii. ⁵¹ Paul and Barnabas shook the <u>dust</u> from their feet, when they were expelled from Antioch in Pisidia, and went to **Iconium**.
- xiii. 52 The disciples were filled with **Joy** and with the **Holy Spirit**.
