Acts of the Apostles - Chapter 16 - Read & Answer

- 1. Paul went on also to <u>DER'BE</u> and to <u>LYS'TRA</u> where there was a disciple named <u>Timothy</u>, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer; but his father was a <u>Greek</u>.
- 2. The <u>Churches</u> were strengthened in the faith and increased in numbers daily.
- 3. Paul & Timothy came opposite <u>Mysia</u> they attempted to go into <u>Bithynia</u>, but the <u>Spirit of Jesus</u> did not allow them.
- 4. During the night <u>Paul</u> had a vision: there stood a man of <u>Macedonia</u> pleading with him and saying, "Come over to <u>Macedonia</u> and help us.
- Paul & Timothy set sail from <u>Tro'as</u> and took a straight course to <u>Samothrace</u> the following day to <u>Neapolis</u> and from there to <u>Philippi</u>.
- 6. A certain woman named <u>Lydia</u>, a worshiper of God, was listening to us; she was from the city of <u>Thyatira</u> and a dealer in <u>purple</u> cloth.
- 7. The slave girl was crying out, "These men are slaves of the **Most High God** who proclaim to you a way of **Salvation**".

- 1. Paul, very much <u>annoyed</u>, turned and said to the spirit, "I order you in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> to come out of her."
- 2. About midnight <u>Paul</u> and <u>Silas</u> were praying and singing hymns to God, and the <u>prisoners</u> were listening to them. Suddenly there was an <u>earthquake</u>, so violent that the <u>foundations</u> of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were <u>unfastened</u>.
