## Scriptures - Influence in our life

We are faced with variety of decisions but to make the correct decision is one's individual choice. In the same way "all scriptures are useful for teaching and turning back error, for correction and for showing you what is right and just and good"


## The New Testament - The Christian Scriptures

> The New Testament contains a collection of books that help us live as followers of Jesus and to make the kinds of decisions.

## What is an Epistle?:

An Epistle is: a) one of the letters adopted as books of the New Testament
b) a liturgical lection usually from one of the New Testament

An Epistle was a letter written on a scroll most often dictated by an author to a scribe and then reviewed by the author before being delivered by a trustworthy messenger. Epistles in the Scriptures are only found in the New Testament.

Letters, or Epistles, of encouragement and corrections were sent to churches and to individuals. 22 Epistles/Letters are part of the New Testament. All the letters contain messages that teach Christians and help them live out their vocation. The first 21 letters help Christians make important decisions. The last letter, Revelation, helps Christians prepare for a future that is in God's hands.

How Scriptures help us to make our decisions?

1. Will your decision bring you to a place where you're closer to
Christ or further away from Him?
(1 Cor. 10:23.24)
2. Will your decision bring you to a place that will cause another Believer to stumble? (Mark 9:42)
3. Will your decision cause you to be strengthened, encouraged, and equipped in the Lord?
(1 Cor. 8:13)
4. Will your decision ultimately glorify the Lord?
(1 Cor. 10:31)
