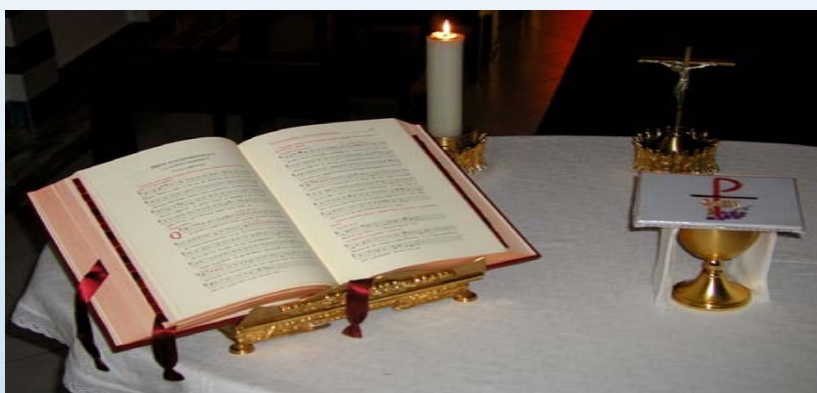


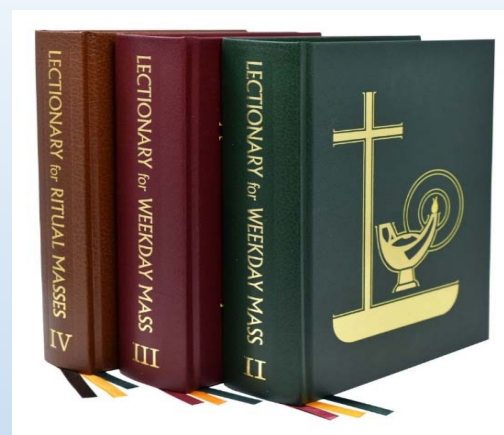
SACRED OBJECTS



The **Roman Missal** (Latin: **Missale Romanum**) is the liturgical book that contains the texts and instructions for the celebration of the Mass in the **Roman Rite** of the **Catholic Church**.



A **lectern (Ambo)** is a reading desk, with a slanted top, usually placed on a stand or affixed to some other form of support, on which documents or books are placed as support for reading , Mass readings, Homily (sermon).



A **lectionary** (Latin: lectionarium) is a book or listing that contains a collection of scripture readings appointed for Christian worship on a given day or different occasions.

SACRED OBJECTS



Ciborium – it is used to hold the hosts for Holy Communion



Chalice – The cup in which the priest holds the wine to be consecrated



Cruets – Small vessels that hold the wine and water



Paten and Host – round golden plate used to hold the Eucharistic bread the host consecration



Corporal – A linen cloth spread on the altar to keep the vessels of bread and wine



Purificator - The cloth which priest using to cleanse the Chalice

SACRED OBJECTS



Pall – It is stiff square cover which is placed over the Chalice



Lavabo Bowl & Towel – Used by priest to wash his hands after he offered the bread and wine



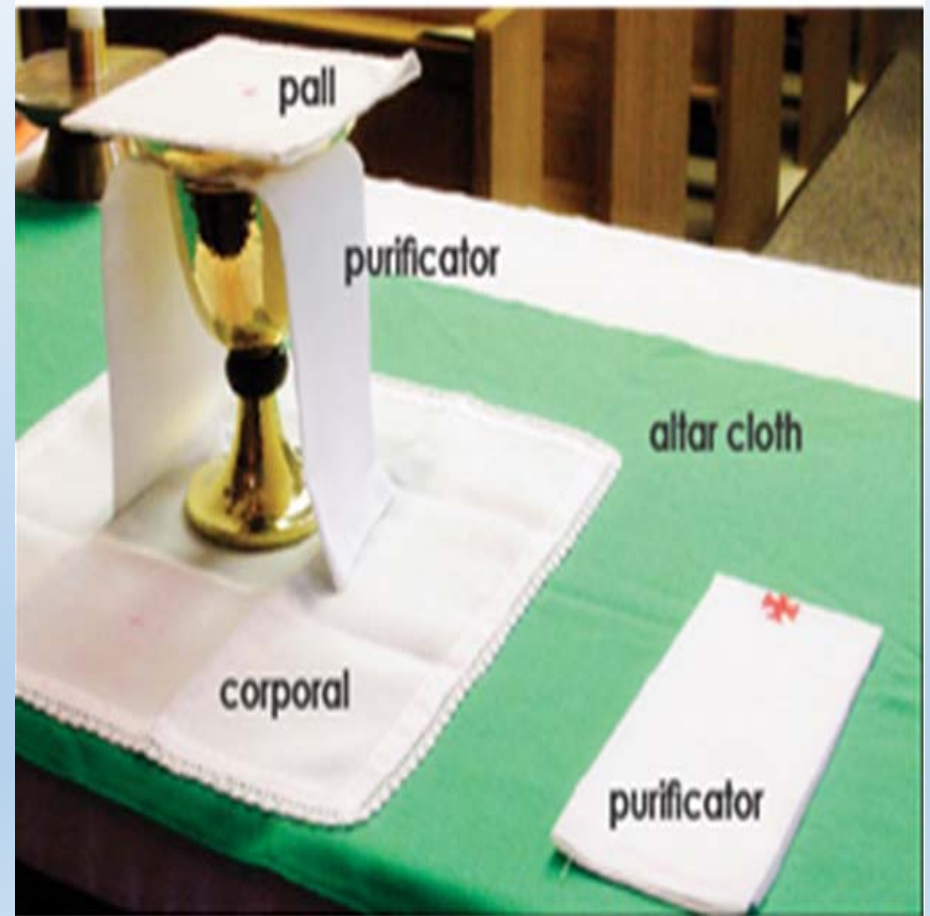
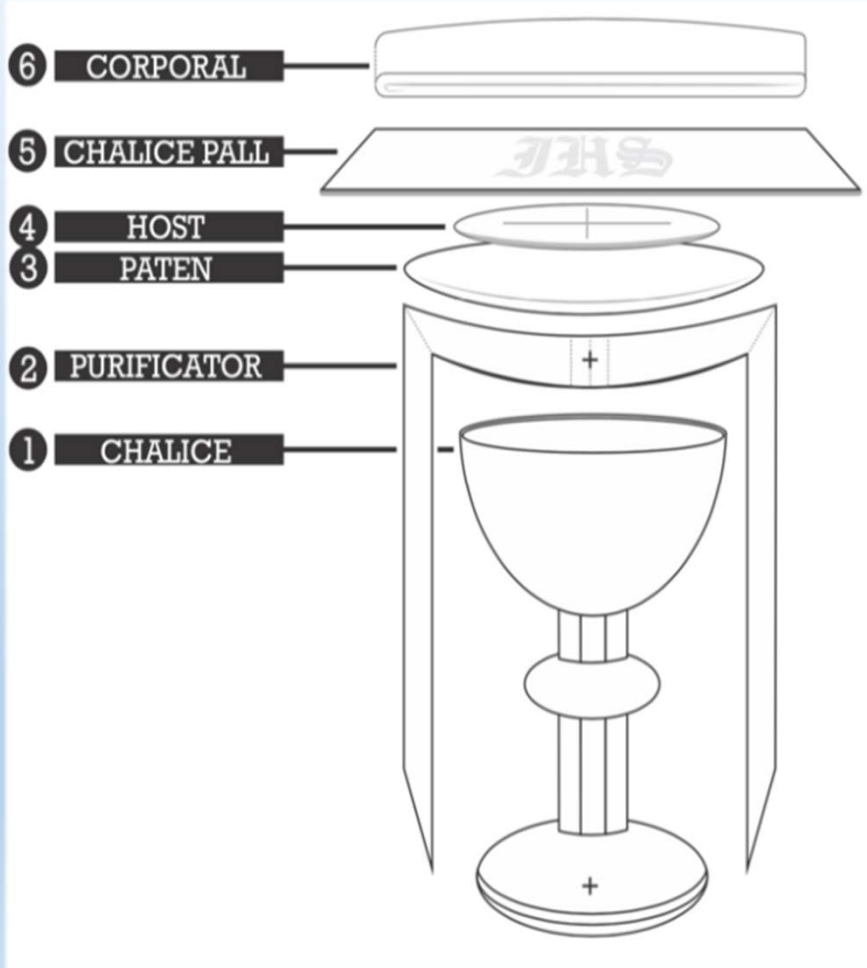
Tabernacle - an ornamental locked box where Holy Communion kept. We genuflect in front of Tabernacle to show reverence

A **priest washes his hands** as a sign of **his** spiritual cleansing and preparation to **wash** away **his** impurities before handling the consecrated Eucharist which is holy and sacred. It is meant as an act of humility and respect which should be given to God.



Altar - the table on which the bread and wine are Consecrated during communion services.

HOW TO ARRANGE CHALICE



SACRED OBJECTS

Benediction – service of special devotion to Eucharist (**Holy hour adoration**)

Thurible – metal container that hold hot charcoal for incense. Carried in right hand of thurifer

Boat – small container that holds the incense. Carried in left hand of thurifer.

Thurifer – Altar server who carries the Thurible and boat.

Pascal candle –

large wax candle placed in tall holder to symbolize light of Risen Christ. It is the “Easter Candle” and is blessed and Prepared at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. night. Stays in Sanctuary until end of Pentecost then placed near baptismal font and used for Baptisms and funerals.

Sprinkler

liturgical implement or pail used to sprinkle holy water for Sprinkling Rites of the church



Bells during Consecration : The primary reason for the **use of bells** is to create a joyful noise to the Lord as a way to give thanks for the miracle taking place on the altar.
