7. On the first / last day of the week, the disciples were together to break bread. Paul preached until midnight because they were leaving the next day. 8. The lamps were lit and Eutychus was sitting in a window. He fell into a deep sleep and jumped / fell out of the window on the first / second / third floor and died / woke up.

10. Paul went down to him and embraced him. He told everyone, "He lives." 12. The people were comforted / sad Eutychus was alive!
