LESSON 18 – THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

Q1. What must we do when we sin?

We must make up for our sins, firstly by going for confession, by doing our penance properly, and by our good actions towards other people (friends, siblings, parents, teachers, Priests, etc.)

Q2. Why should we go for confession?

Confession is one of the Sacraments through which abundant grace is received. We need this grace in order that we might not fall into temptation again and to grow spiritually.

Q3. How can you prepare for a good Confession?

- Examination of Conscience Know your sins.
- Contrition Be sorry for your sins.
- Decide not to sin again.

Q4. Why do we have to go to a priest for Confession?

Jesus himself has given authority to the apostles to forgive sins. Only the Priest has the right from the Church to absolve us from sins through the Sacrament of confession.

Q5. When did Jesus give priests the power to forgive sins?

In John 20:23 we read, "If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven.

Q6. What are the steps for a good confession?

- Do the Sign of the Cross and then say 'Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been [days/months/years] since my last confession
- These are my sins: Confess your Sins
- Penance & Counsel
- Act of Contrition say sorry to Jesus
- Prayer of Absolution
- Sign of the Cross

Q7. How do we obey God?

By following the 10 commandments. We have an inner conscience which is the voice of the Holy Spirit, thus we need to train our conscience well and listen to it too.
