**Good Friday**

On **Good Friday** Jesus is scourged, beaten and crowned with thorns.

Jesus was Forced to carry the cross to the Calvary.

During his way to Calvary Jesus falls three times.

Simon of Cyrene helped Jesus carry his cross.

Jesus is nailed to the Cross and Crucified.

Therefore, we fast on Good Friday to remember His suffering and as penance for our sins.

**Why is it called Good Friday?**

Because Jesus Christ chose to die for our sins so that we can be with him in heaven forever.

**Easter Sunday** it is the celebration of Jesus Christ rising from the dead.

**Resurrection** is the rising of Jesus three days after His death. His tomb was empty.

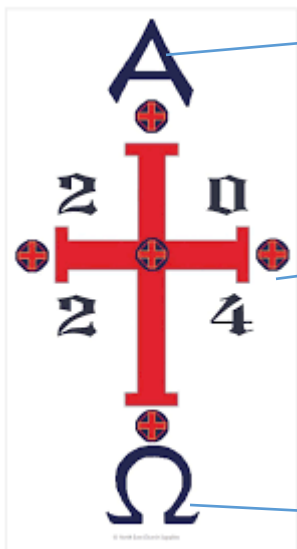

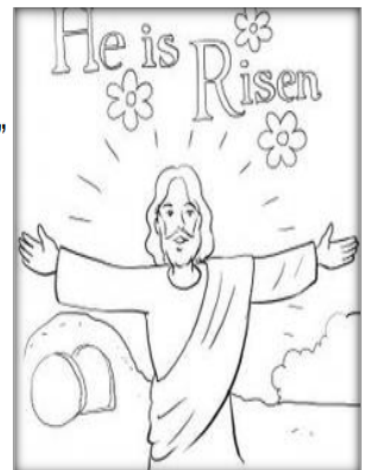
