Maundy Thursday is also known as Holy Thursday

It comes a day before Good Friday.

Jesus had his last meal with his 12 disciples "The Last Supper" He raised the bread and said to his disciple

"This is my body which will be given for you, do this in memory of me"

Then he took the cup saying,

"This cup is a new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you"

Jesus was betrayed by Judas



<u>Good Friday</u>

On **Good Friday** Jesus is scourged, beaten and crowned with thorns.

Jesus was Forced to carry the cross to the Calvary.

During his way to Calvary Jesus falls three times.

Simon of Cyrene helped Jesus carry his cross.

Jesus is nailed to the Cross and Crucified.

Therefore, we fast on Good Friday to remember His suffering and as penance for our sins.

Why is it called **Good Friday**?

Because Jesus Christ chose to die for our sins so that we can be with him in heaven forever.


Easter Sunday it is the celebration of Jesus Christ rising from the dead.

Resurrection is the rising of Jesus three days after His death. His tomb was empty.




