Question and Answer:

Q1. What were the chief sufferings of Christ?

A1. The Chief Sufferings of Christ were:

1. His Agony,
2. His Sweat of Blood in the Garden Gethsemane,
3. His Being scourged at the Pillar,
4. His carrying of the Cross,
5. His Crucifixion, and
6. His Death between two thieves.

Q2. Who helped Jesus carry the Cross?

A2. Simon from Cyrene helped Jesus carry the Cross.

Q3. Who stood by the Cross with Jesus?

A3. Mary and John stood by Jesus the whole time.

Q4. Why did our Savior suffer?

A4. Our Savior suffered to atone for our sins, and to purchase for us eternal life.
