LESSON 28: OUR LIFE IN THE CHURCH

Jesus gave us signs of His grace in the seven sacraments. The first sacrament we receive is Baptism. The signs of this sacrament are words and water. Our parent and godparents made our baptismal promises for us because we were too young to speak. Then the priest poured water over our heads and baptized us. At that very moment, our original sin was washed away, and our soul was filled with God's life, called grace.

In the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, God gives us His own Son as food for our souls. Bread, wine and the words of the priest are our signs that Jesus is present. If we receive this sacrament often, the life of grace in our soul grows more and more strong.

In the sacrament of Penance, God gives us the chance to win back grace that we have lost in sin. The priest's healing, forgiving words are the sign of God's presence.

In the sacrament of Confirmation, the Holy Spirit fills us with the grace to be even stronger members of the Church. Later in life, we may receive some other sacrament: Holy Order, Matrimony (marriage), or the Sacrament of the Sick.

When we are full of God's grace, it is easier to keep our promises to God and follow His Commandments.

"Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in the one body". (Colossians 3: 14-15)

"If you continue in my word, you are truly My disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free". (John 8:31-32)

Words to know:

Sacrament: a sign given by Jesus that gives us grace.

Christian: a baptized follower of Jesus Christ.

	The sacraments make us holy either by giving us the first sanctifying grace, which takes away sin, or by increasing that grace which we already possess.

	Baptism is the sacrament which makes us Christians, that is, followers of Jesus Christ, sons of God, and members of the Church.
4	How is Baptism given?
	Baptism is given by pouring water on the head of the person to be baptized and saying the baptismal words at the same time.
