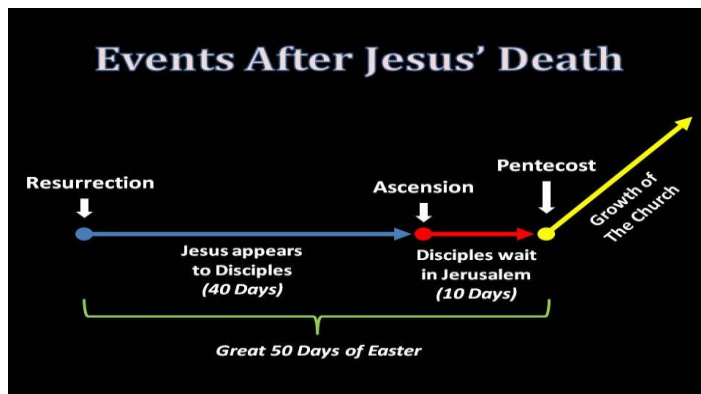
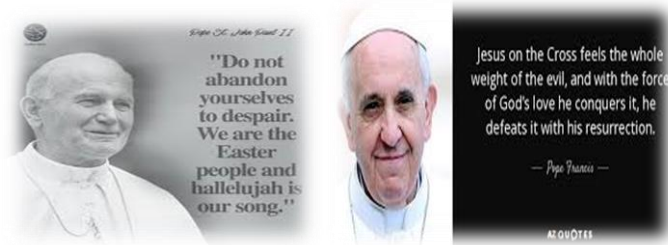


FORMATION 14 : The Resurrection: God is Victorious

Memory Verse

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even

though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

The **Sacred Triduum or Paschal Triduum**; Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one-day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery
Maundy Thursday + Good Friday+ Easter Vigil

The **sacrament of penance** calling us to live a resurrected life after every Eucharistic celebration.

QUESTIONS WITH BIBLICAL REFERENCES:

- Question 1: The chief priests didn't want the Jews to believe Jesus. They told Pilate that Jesus' disciples may try to "steal" Jesus and claim He rose in three days. What did they do? (Matthew 27:62-66)(they told to secure the tomb until the third day)
- Question 2: When did Mary Magdalene and Mary (the mother of James) visit Jesus's tomb and discover He was gone? (John 20:1; Matt 28:1; Mark 16:1)(first day of the week at dawn)
- Question 3: "There was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and _____. His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow" (Matthew 28:3).(His appearance was like lightening and his clothing white as snow)
- Question 4: The soldiers were terrified when they saw the angel, and they told the chief priests what happened. These priests schemed with the elders and came up with a plan. What did they do? (Matthew 28:12)(they devised a plan to give large sum of money to the soldiers)
- Question 5: Then, Mary Magdalene ran and told two apostles, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him." Which two apostles did Mary tell first? (John 20:2)(Simon Peter and the disciple Jesus loved most)
- Question 6: The two apostles saw the handkerchief that had been around His head and linen clothes. They were folded. Peter and John didn't understand the Scripture that this would happen. But, when John came to the tomb, he believed. What did the apostles do next? (John 20:10;21:24)(Returned to their homes)
- Question 7: While outside the tomb, two angels asked Mary why she was weeping. Then, Jesus asked her the same question. Mary thought He was a gardener. She answered... (John 20:15)(Sir if you have carried Him away tell me where you have laid Him and I will take him away)
- Question 8: "Jesus said to her, 'Mary!' She turned and said to Him, 'Rabboni!' (which is to say, _____)" (John 20:16).(Teacher)
- Question 9: On a 7 mile road to Emmaus, Jesus found two people and joined their conversation. Without them knowing this was Jesus, they said Jesus was a mighty Prophet, delivered to be

condemned to death by the chief priests, and how they hoped He would redeem Israel. What was the name of one of these travelers? (Luke 24:13-35)(Cleopas)

- Question 10: Cleopas and the other person told the 11 disciples that Jesus has risen (Luke 24:33). Now, do all of the disciples believe (Mark 16:14)?(Not all of them Believed)
- Question 11: After Jesus speaks with the disciples, He asks for food. What do they give him to eat? (Luke 24:42)(A piece of Broiled fish)
- Question 12: Which disciple said this? “Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe.” (John 20:25)(Thomas)
- Question 13: “Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷ and that repentance and ----- of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. (Luke 24:46-47).(Forgiveness)
- Question 14: And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is _____ will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned” (Mark 16:15-16).(Baptized)
- Question 15: Without Jesus, the disciples went to the Sea of Tiberias to go fishing. They hadn’t caught any fish yet until Jesus from the shore told them to cast the net on the right side of the boat. When the disciples on the boat did that, it was too many fish to bring in. Who first recognized that Jesus was on the shore? (John 21:7,24)(the disciple Jesus loved the most)
- Question 16: The other disciples came from the shore to drag the net filled with 153 large fish back to the shore. For the third time, Jesus appeared to the disciples since being raised from the dead. He told them to “come and eat breakfast.” Did the disciples realize it was Him? (John 21:11-14)(They knew it was the Lord)
- Question 17: At a mountain in Galilee, with the 11 disciples, Jesus asked them to do three things. Which of these did He ask of them? (Matthew 28:16-20)(Baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit)
- Question 18: Jesus did many signs in front of the disciples. Why were these signs written down for us to read? (John 20:30-31)(we may believe Jesus is the Messiah)
- Question 19: Right before Jesus ascended to Heaven, He blessed his disciples in what town? (Luke 24:50)(Bethany)
- Question 20: What did the disciples do immediately after Jesus left? (Luke 24:53)(they were in the temple blessing God)
