LESSON 21 – JESUS DIES FOR US

Q1. What did Jesus Christ do to save us?

A1. Jesus died to save us, and rose again on the third day to save us from sin, and conquered death. The Catholic Church teaches that salvation comes through Jesus alone (Acts 4:12), since he is the "one mediator between God and man" (1 Tm 2:5-6)

Q2. According to the Jews what crimes did Jesus commit that he was put to death?

A2. According to the Jews, Jesus was found guilty of: violating the Sabbath law (by healing on the Sabbath); threatening to destroy the Jewish Temple; practicing sorcery, exorcising people by the power of demons; and claiming to be the Messiah.

Q3. What is the Bible verse that tells us why Jesus died for us?

A3. The Bible tells us that (John 3:16) 'For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life'.
