Q1: Who was Eli?

Ans: Eli was a devoted high priest who served 40 years as judge of Israel.

Q2: What does Hannah's prayer mean in 1 Samuel chapter 2?

Ans: Hannah prays to express her thankfulness to God, as she looks back on her life, she sees God's goodness, faithfulness and blessings.

Q3: How does Hannah proclaim God's Holiness and Sovereignty:

Ans: Hannah proclaims, "There is none holy like the LORD; there is none besides You; there is no Rock like our God"

Q4: How many sons did he have and what were their names? How was their character?
